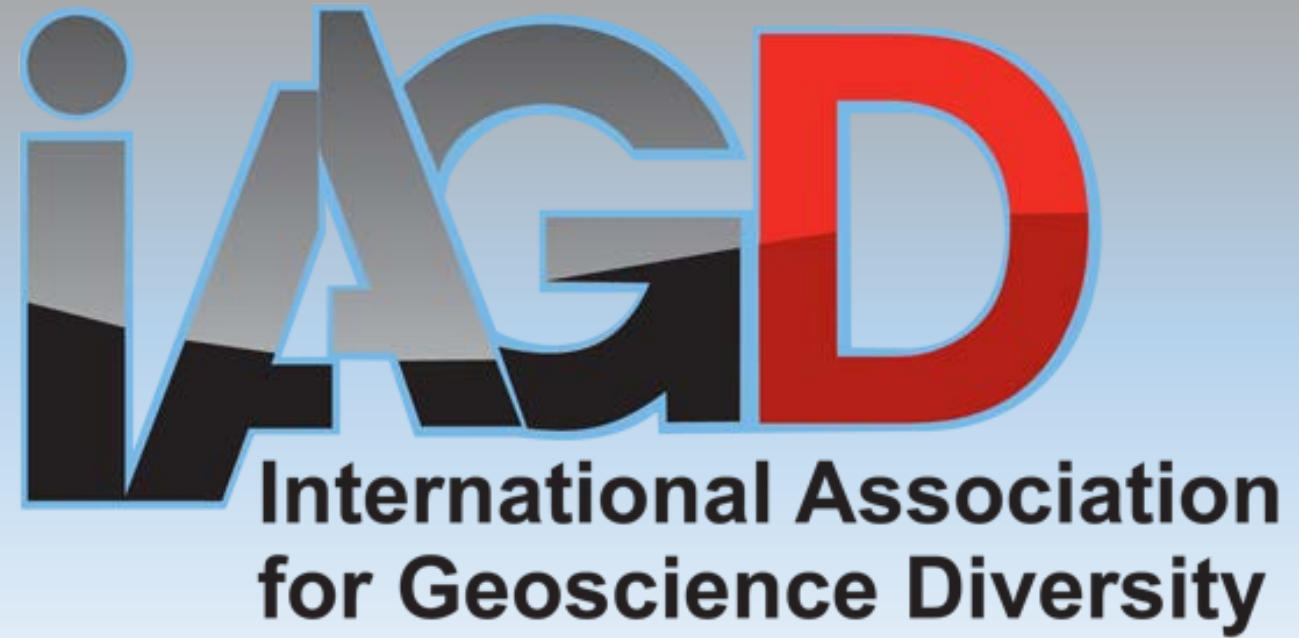


The **IAGD Mission** is to improve access to the geosciences for individuals with disabilities and promote communities of research, instruction, and student support.

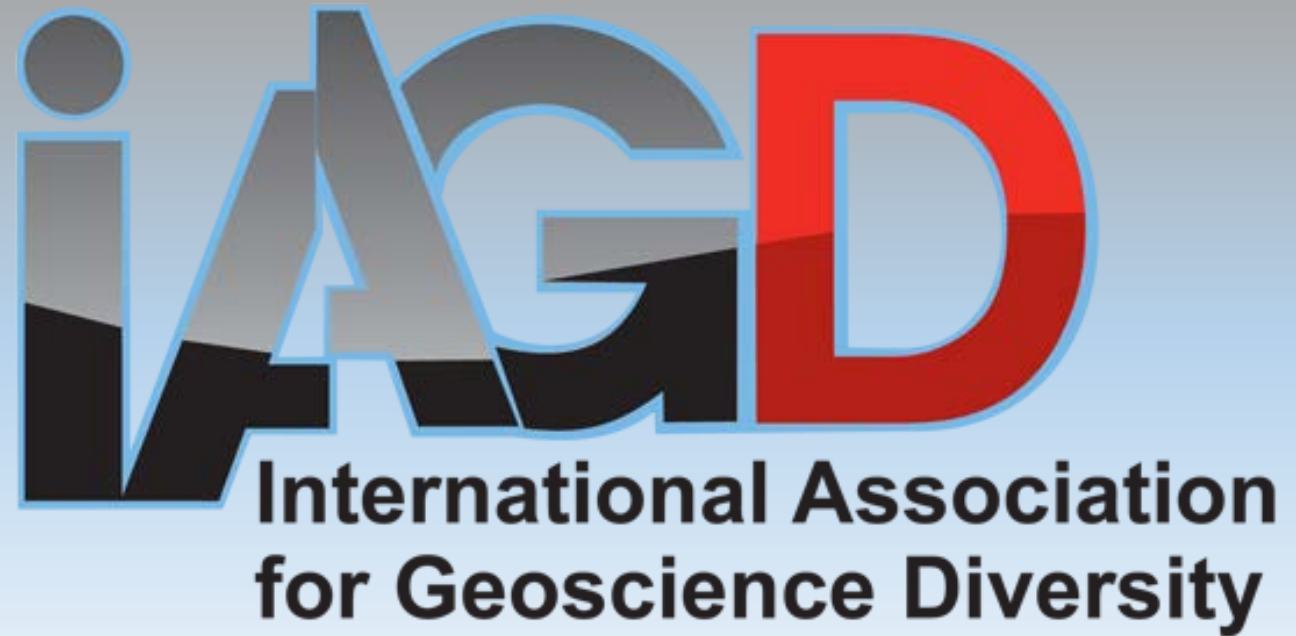


The **IAGD Vision**
